Indigenous Travel Grant Guideline and Application

Grant Purpose and Value

To broaden participation at the 2nd Australasian FASD Conference a limited number of Travel Grants will be awarded to subsidise the cost of conference attendance. Recipients of the travel subsidies must be prepared to attend the full 2 days of the conference, be available to meet the sponsor and have photos taken for later inclusion in media and promotion by both FASD Research Australia Centre of Research Excellence and the sponsor, and provide feedback to the Organising Committee following the conference.

Travel Grants can only be used to cover registration, travel and accommodation costs for the FASD 2018 Conference. The amount of the travel grant will be determined by the applicant's place of residence as outlined in the table below:

Conference organisers will register recipients for the conference and book the accommodation for successful applicants. Successful applicants will need to book their own flights - the cost of flights will be reimbursed upon receipt of confirmation of flight booking.

Who can apply for Indigenous Travel Grants?

Scholarships applicants who are

- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people of Australia, or
- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person as a nominated representative of an Aboriginal Controlled Health Organisation or Not-for-Profit Aboriginal service provider, or
- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Parent/kinship carer of child diagnosed with or suspected of having FASD

The Grant is not open to Commonwealth, State or Territory Government employees. Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander students should complete the Student Travel Grant Application Form instead of this form.
