PARENT/CARER Travel Grant Guideline and Application

Grant Purpose and Value

To broaden participation at the 2nd Australasian FASD Conference a limited number of Travel Grants will be awarded to subsidise the cost of conference attendance. Recipients of the travel subsidies must be prepared to attend the full 2 days of the conference, be available to meet the sponsor and have photos taken for later inclusion in media and promotion by both FASD Research Australia Centre of Research Excellence and the sponsor, and provide feedback to the Organising Committee following the conference.

Travel Grants can only be used to cover registration, travel and accommodation costs for the FASD 2018 Conference. The amount of the travel grant will be determined by the applicant's place of residence as outlined in the table below:

Conference organisers will register recipients for the conference and book the accommodation for successful applicants. Successful applicants will need to book their own flights - the cost of flights will be reimbursed upon receipt of confirmation of flight booking.

Who can apply for Parent/Carer Travel Grants?

Scholarships are available for

- Australian residents
- Person currently caring for a person/people diagnosed with or suspected of having FASD
- Foster carer who is registered to care for children with or suspected of having FASD through Child Protection or a Foster Care Organisation

People who are able to share information gathered at the FASD2018 Conference with other parents and carers will be favourably considered.
