### Student Travel Grant Guideline and Application

#### Grant Purpose and Value

To broaden participation at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Australasian FASD Conference a limited number of Travel Grants will be awarded to subsidise the cost of conference attendance. Recipients of the travel subsidies must be prepared to attend the full 2 days of the conference, be available to meet the sponsor and have photos taken for later inclusion in media and promotion by both FASD Research Australia Centre of Research Excellence and the sponsor, and provide feedback to the Organising Committee following the conference.

Travel Grants can only be used to cover registration, travel and accommodation costs for the FASD 2018 Conference. The amount of the travel grant will be determined by the applicant's place of residence as outlined in the table below:

Conference organisers will register recipients for the conference and book the accommodation for successful applicants. Successful applicants will need to book their own flights - the cost of flights will be reimbursed upon receipt of confirmation of flight booking.

- Currently or have been enrolled in an Australian or New Zealand University in 2018
- Enrolled full or part-time at Masters or PhD Level
- Not in receipt of another travel grant to attend this conference
- Have the support of their Supervisor

Students who are presenting a paper or poster will be favourably considered.
